



HOW DOES MY DISTRICT SIGN UP FOR NWEA MAP GROWTH AND SLO APPR RESULTS?

NWEA MAP assessments are approved for use in a **growth model** and in **Student Learning Objectives (SLOs)** for **math, reading, and language usage for grades K-10** under Education Law 3012-D. Since 2012, NWEA has partnered with Education Analytics (EA) to deliver APPR results to New York districts. EA's full suite of results is Included in your MAP subscription cost for the 2016-17 school year. Your district can receive teacher-level, grade-level, and school-level growth model and SLO results by completing the following steps:

When?	Steps	Steps to receive full Results from EA
May 2017	Sign up to electronically sign data sharing agreement & release MAP results to EA for analysis	✓
June 12 2017	Optional: Attend webinar for an overview of data collection process & how EA computes the 0-20 APPR scale for your results	
June 19- July 7 2017	Upload/transfer SIRS data to EA's secure site (if EA is unable to collect from your RIC)*	✓
July 7 2017	Recommended: Upload completed expected teachers template	
July 31 2017	Optional: Attend EA webinar on reviewing and interpreting preliminary results	
July 31 - August 11 2017	Recommended: Embargo period: review preliminary results & share additional information and/or feedback to EA	
August 18 2017	Download your final results for K-10 Math, Reading & Language Usage	✓
August 2017	Optional: (As a district) Determine whether to use one of the methods (SLO or growth model) for APPR & submit to state (Or just use the results for informational purposes)	

* Must upload SIRS data to receive full results; otherwise will receive Grade-Level and School-Level SLO results only
